



Trociare Collection

This is necessary to ensure the poorest and most vulnerable of our brothers and sisters in developing countries receive our support as quickly as possible, especially in the light of Covid 19. Building Fund Envelopes: We thank those who have dropped in building fund donations using their own envelopes, which is very much appreciated at this time. The envelope boxes were to be distributed in early April but the present pandemic prevented this happening, however they will be delivered as soon as physically possible. We ask people not to leave envelopes in the church, but you can use the letter box at the parochial house.
