Professional staff are available to answer queries and give advice and reassurance where necessary. The support line is open Monday to Friday, 8am-8pm, by calling 0818 222 024. Hours may be extended to meet the demand.

Trociare Collection

Over Pentecost weekend, 30th/31st May people in every parish are asked by the Bishops to return their Trociare donations. These donations can be made online, by phone, by post to Trocaire or to the parochial house. Please do not leave them in the Churches. This is necessary to ensure the poorest and most vulnerable of our brothers and sisters in developing countries receive our support as quickly as possible, especially in the light of Covid 19. Thank you for your support. **To facilitate the collection of the Trocaire boxes they can be dropped into the parish office in the coming week on Tuesday or Friday from 12 noon to 3pm. Also Fr. Brendan will be at Ardcath Church on the 6th of June from 2pm to 2.45pm which is another option.**

Building Fund Envelopes: We thank those who have dropped in building fund donations using their own envelopes, which is very much appreciated at this time. The envelope boxes were to be distributed in early April but the present pandemic prevented this happening, however they will be delivered as soon as physically possible. We ask people not to leave envelopes in the church, but you can use the letter box at the parochial house.
