Mass, Funerals, Weddings, Baptism's sacraments

The present guidelines regarding Covid allow for a certain number of places in each of our churches. We ask people to note that going forward this will dictate the capacity of the numbers attending our sacraments. These Government guidelines are for everyone's protection and we ask you to please assist us in adhering to them.

Allowing for 'social distancing' of approximately 2 meters our church of St Andrew's has 36 places, further 12 persons in the Parish Centre. St Mary's has 38 places, and in St John the Baptist there are 21 places. Within the church a 'place' can be occupied by family members seated together, or by an individual on her/his own. Presently the Government have capped the maximum number in the church allowed to 50 people. These Public Health Guidelines from the HSE while challenging are for all our benefits and we ask you for your cooperation.
