simplicity.

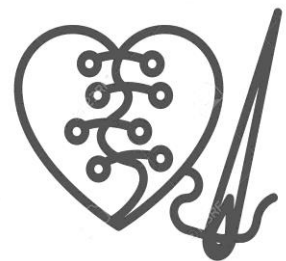
Fast from pressures and be prayerful.
