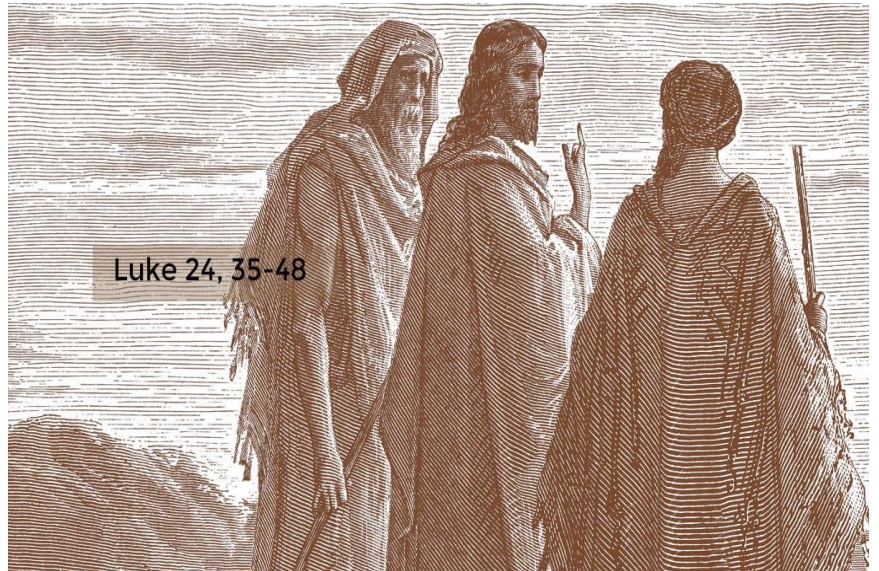

Reflection
