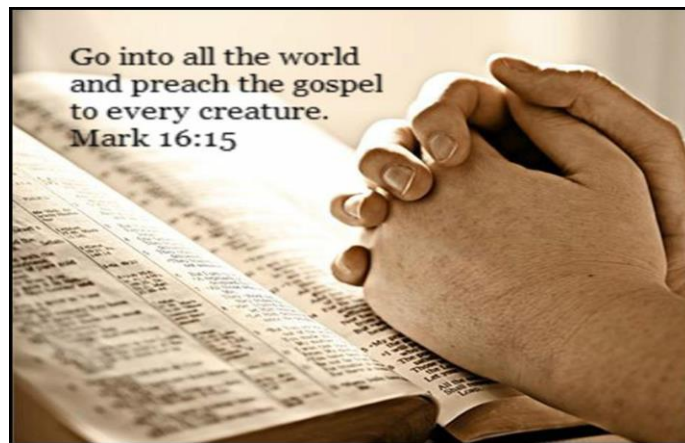

Government Guidelines going forward for our Sacraments:

“Before each Mass our Churches will be sanitised with our Fogger machine.”

- **Masks must be worn in the church at all times**
- **Hands will be sanitized when entering the church**
- **2mtr distancing will remain in Church, family groups may sit together. Overall numbers attending must not exceed 50**
- **Stewards will show you to your seat filling the church from front to back**
- **People are requested to leave the church starting from the back moving to the front**
- **It is also requested people not to congregate outside the church before or after the Sacraments.**
