Dear Parishioners.

For years past our Cemetery Devotions have had a very important significance in our parish calendar. We all congregated to remember and celebrate the lives of our loved ones, to pray for and bless them. Regrettably, like last year this year it may not be possible to have our usual public devotions due to continuing Covid 19 pandemic and public health restrictions.

What we propose to do is in the week before our respective parish dates is to make a video recording of the blessing of the graves which will then be available online after the parish celebration of Sunday Mass at 11.30am .

The recording will take place in the week before the cemetery devotion date which is listed below. These are dependent on good weather and the availability of the videographer and myself. I'm sure you all appreciate and understand in current circumstances no one but the videographer and myself can be present during videoing.

Those who wish to prepare their family graves should do so by noon of the Monday of the cemetery devotions date. These arrangements will be reviewed further to whatever public health advice is in place.

We will keep these proposals under constant review. Public safety is paramount in these times.
