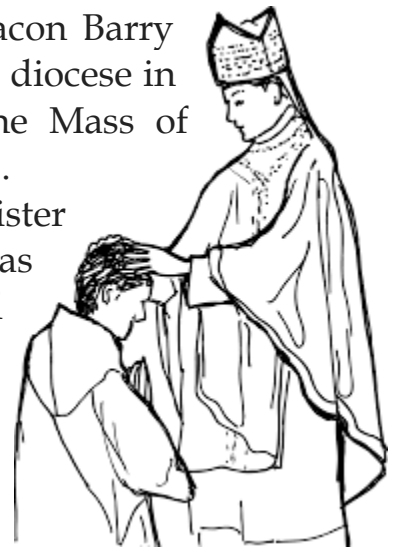

CATECHISM CORNER

The 10 Commandments "Teacher, what good must I do to have eternal life?" (Matthew 19:16). To the young man who asked this question, Jesus answered, "If you would enter into life, keep the commandments", and then he added, "Come, follow Me" (Matthew 19:16-21). To follow Jesus involves keeping the commandments. The law has not been abolished but we are invited to rediscover it in the Person of the divine Master who realised it perfectly in himself, revealed its full meaning and attested to its permanent validity.

Duty towards God (1-3)

1. I am the LORD your God: you shall not have strange Gods before me.
2. You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain.
3. Remember to keep holy the LORD'S day.

Duty towards Others (4-10)

4. Honor your father and your mother.
5. You shall not kill.
6. You shall not commit adultery.

7. You shall not steal.
8. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
9. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife.
10. You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.
