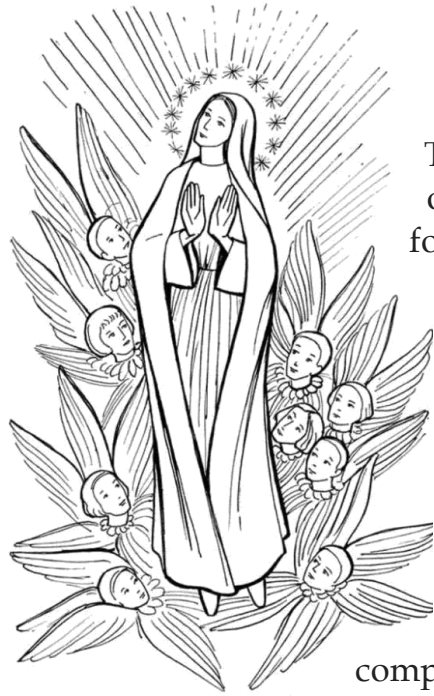

## 15th August - Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

### Holy Mass of the Assumption

St Mary's Church, Ardcath 9:30am

St Andrew's Church, Curraha 7:30pm



The celebration of the Assumption of Mary into heaven is a Holy Day of Obligation, providing us with a wonderful opportunity to praise God for the graces that He bestowed on our Blessed Mother by bringing her Body and Soul into heaven. It was widely held through Christian history of the special privilege given to Mary at the end of her earthly life, but it was only in the Marian Jubilee year of 1950 that Pope Pius XII formally defined it as an article of faith. *"We proclaim and define it to be a dogma revealed by God that the immaculate Mother of God, Mary ever virgin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven. Munificentissimus Deus.* Today is a day held with great solemnity in many Christian countries with special processions, festive foods and vesperal fireworks. Mary completed her life as a shining example to the human race, and so too the perspective of the gift of assumption is offered to the whole human race as we pray in the creed that 'we believe in the resurrection of the body and life everlasting'".
