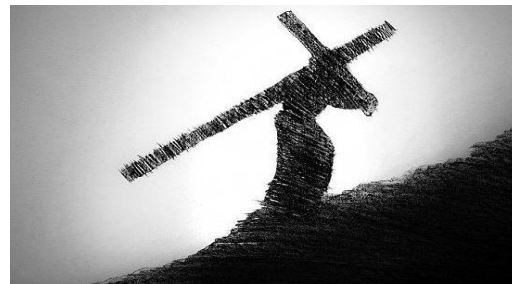

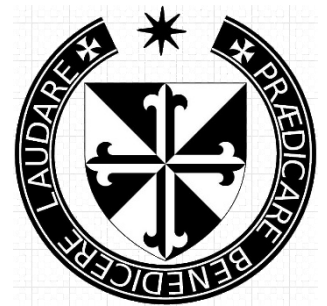
Pope Francis' Intention for September 2022
