Solemnity of All Saints - 1st November

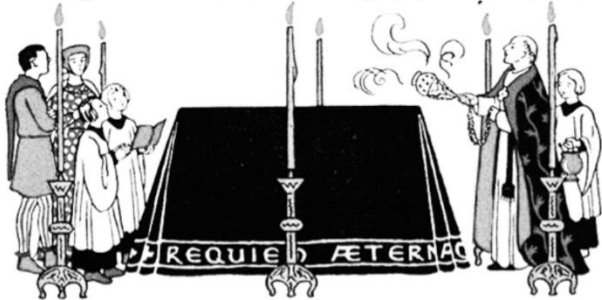
