2/ In any walk of life, troubles will come. Jesus encourages his listeners to stand firm in such circumstances, telling them 'your endurance will win you your lives'.

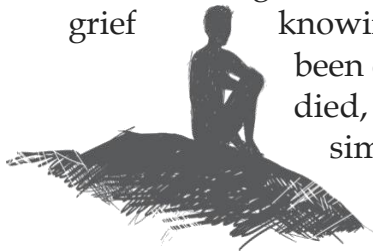
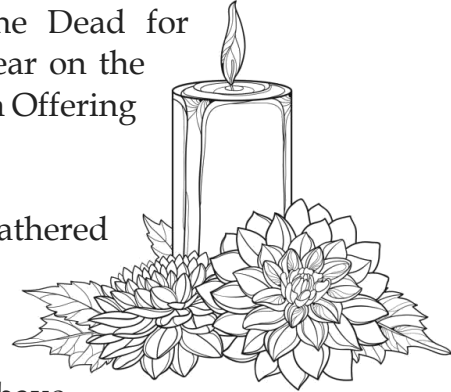

RIP: Fr Colm Murtagh, retired Parish Priest of Kildalkey, the oldest priest of our diocese was called to the Father's House on Tuesday Evening. Fr Colm Murtagh was born on 17 October 1925 in Coole Parish, Co. Westmeath. He was educated at St Finian's College and St Patrick's College, Maynooth and was ordained in 1950. Fr Murtagh served in the parishes of Oldcastle, Mullingar and Ballivor (1950-1952), as hospital chaplain in Navan in 1953. He was appointed Curate in Ratoath in 1957 and then served in the parishes of Eglisk (1958), Enfield (1967) and Rochfortbridge (1972) before his appointment as Parish Priest of Kildalkey in January 1981. He retired in September 2005 and continued to reside in the parish since then. His funeral took place on Friday, 11th Nov. in St Dymphna's Church, Kildalkey.
