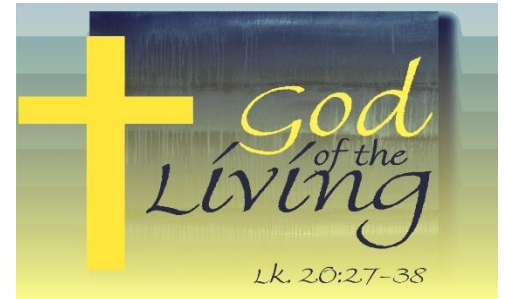

November List of the Dead – Please return your family List of the Dead for Remeberance during the month of the November and throughout the year on the First Fridays of the Month. List of the Dead Envelope can be found in Parish Offering Envelope boxes, and in the churches.

The **Annual Mass for the Bereaved** in our Parish will take place on the weekend of the **12th/13th November**, remembering particularly our Beloved and Faithful Departed who passed away since this time last year. Families who have had a loved ones funeral celebrated in our parish churches are invited to attend.

The 6th November is traditionally held as the feast of All the Saints of Ireland – a celebration of all those who lived the Christian Faith and inspired others to follow the gospel message. Ireland, especially in the early Christian centuries, was known as an 'Isle of Saints and Scholars. More than once, when the rest of western Europe was submerged in ignorance and chaos, Ireland kept learning alive. Many of the Irish saints combined pastoral care with an observance of the monastic life. The Irish

also did much as missionaries, bringing the faith to other parts of Europe, and the story of St Brendan, whether authentic history or not, shows that they set their sights even further afield. Here is the ancient litany of those saints, some widely recognised, some recognised more locally.
