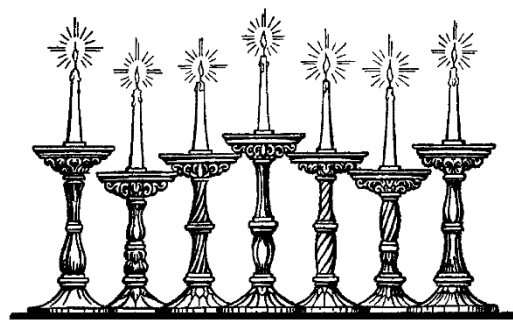

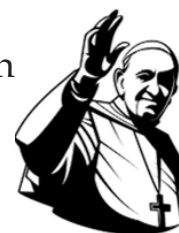
St Paul's Missals: Readers can collect a copy from Fr. Kevin in the Sacristy or in the Parish office.

7th Feb: St Mel, patron saint of the Diocese of Ardagh, Co. Longford



St. Josephine Bakhita

8th Feb: St Josephine Bakhita, (1869-1947): Sudan. Kidnapped while young and sold several times into slavery. Rescued by an Italian family and brought to Italy, where she not only became Catholic, but felt the call to Religious Life, joining the Canossian Daughters of Charity. Patron Saint of Human Trafficking. She is a shining ray of hope for human trafficking victims and an inspirational demonstration of how a victim can recover from their trauma and become whole again. 10th Feb: St Scholastica: Sister of St Benedict and patron saint of sisters. Speaking to her brother: She said, "I asked you for a favour and you would not listen, so I asked God and He did listen!". The power of prayer!
