3rd Sunday of Easter - The Road to Emmaus

The journey of Cleopas and his companion on the road to Emmaus is truly a delightful and powerful account of the Risen Lord's presence with us. So much can be gleaned from praying with this piece of scripture: not least the ways that the Lord can be so near to us, yet going unrecognised. How those words of "so slow to believe the full message of the prophets" can convict our own hearts and our slow sluggish response to God's word. But how beautiful it is to think that we can already see the basic structure of the Mass being set in it: Disciples hearing scripture spoken (the Readings), the Lord giving the explanation and application of the Word of God (the Homily/Sermon) before moving into the Breaking of Bread (the Eucharist), and that final movement with the message to the world "Yes it is true, the Lord has Risen..." (The dismissal).
