Curraha Road Closure: The Water Main works along the Ratoath Road- R155 - in Curraha will move to the area immediately outside St Andrew's Church from Monday 10th July and will continue for at least a week. St Andrew's will remain open as usual, and access to the church and carpark will be maintained throughout the works, as well as to the Parish Office. The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass will be offered at the usual times. Next weekend (15th/16th July) works will begin on the crossroads,

involving a stop/go system. The advice we've been given is to encourage parishioners travelling by car to come from the Ratoath direction. We pray for the success of this project as well as the health and safety of all who are working on it.
