## Holy Mass of the Assumption

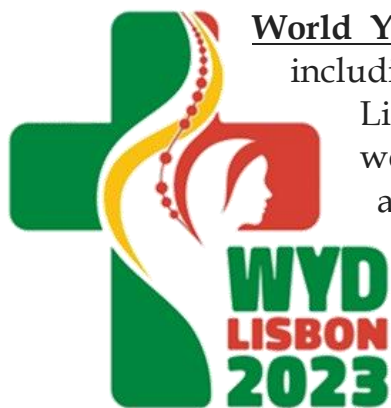
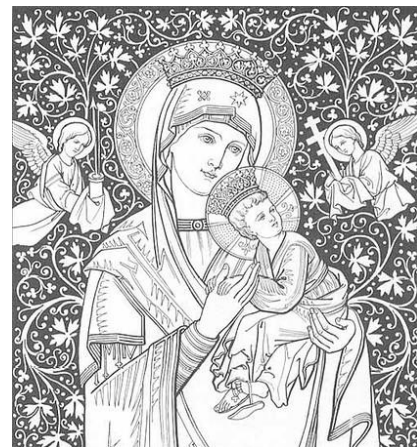
St John the Baptist's Church, Clonalvy 9:30am
