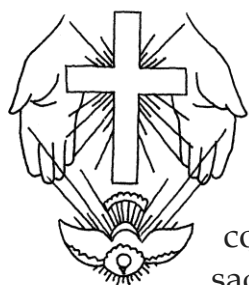

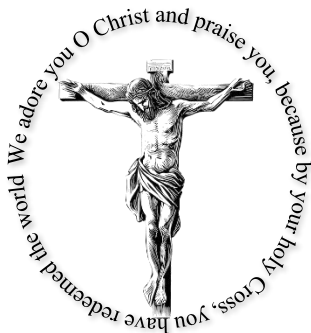

The Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross - 14th September.

This wonderful feast celebrates the date that St Helena, mother of the Emperor Constantine unearthed the Cross of Christ that had long been buried, when the Romans built a pagan temple over the site of Mt. Calvary. A traditional account speaks of a workman, mortally injured during the excavation work was laid on a number of crosses that were discovered at this ancient execution site. As he was laid on one particular cross, he was fully healed, indicating the cross on which Christ died, reminding us of the words of St Peter, "By his wounds, you have been healed". At the 9:30am Mass, parishioners are invited to bring Crucifixes from their homes to be blessed.
