1st November

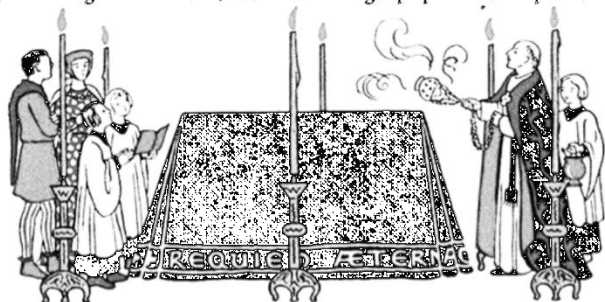

Commemoration of the Faithful Departed (All Souls) - 2nd November

All Souls Day is an invitation for the Faithful on earth (*the Church Militant*) to pray for the souls of the Faithful Departed in Purgatory (*the Church Suffering*) that they may attain to eternal life of heaven. The prayers offered to God to have mercy on the souls of the dead, to purify them by the fire of His charity, and to bring them into His Kingdom of life and light, find particular expression in the life of the Christian Faithful, filled as it with the hope of being reunited

one day in heaven, and in charity in assisting our Beloved Deceased on their perfection by grace. “*It is a good and holy thought to pray for the dead - 2Macc12:46*). Not only do our prayers assist the Faithful Departed, but offer comfort to the Bereaved in their grief at the passing of a Loved One.

Annual Masses for the Bereaved: Families of Parishioners who have passed away since last November are invited to the Annual Masses for the Bereaved which will take place over the weekend of the 4th/5th November. Parishioners are invited to light a candle before Mass and place it at the shrine of prayer for our Faithful Departed, which will remain throughout these final weeks of Ordinary Time
