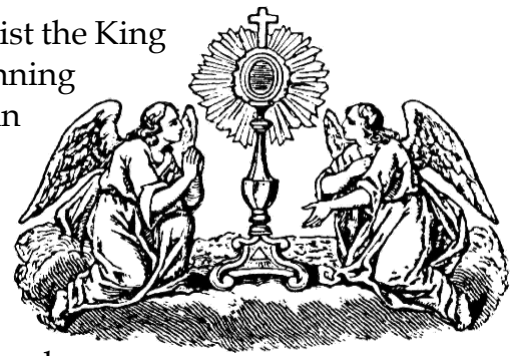

November List of the Dead: As we journey through this month of the Holy Souls, parishioners are asked to prepare their family List of the Dead for prayers throughout November, and the First Friday of the Month. The List of the Dead envelope can be found in the Parish Offertory Envelopes Box or in the church. Please drop them into the basket, the sacristy, or the Parish Office.

40 Hours Eucharistic Adoration: To celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King this year, there will be 40 Hours Adoration in the Cathedral, beginning with Mass at 7:30 pm on Fri. 24th Nov., concluding with Solemn Vespers and Benediction at 4pm, Sun. 26th Nov.

As part of the 40 Hours Devotion, Confessions will be heard in the Cathedral continually from 12 noon to 12 midnight on Sat. 25th Nov. It is hoped that people from the Diocese will come to the Cathedral during this time to pray, and individual Parishes are assigned an hour if they wish to participate. Curraha, Ardcath and Clonalvy have been assigned the hour of 12Noon - 1pm on Sat. 25th Nov., along with Ashbourne, Dunboyne, Kilbride and Carnaross. While each parish of the diocese will be assigned to a particular hour of adoration, people are in no way restricted to their parish's hour. It is hoped that people from the Diocese will come to the Cathedral during this time to pray.



Curraha Confirmation Preparation Sunday: Next Sunday, we welcome the children preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation, as they mark the Ceremony of Light – reflecting on Jesus’ words that *“I am the Light of the World, Anyone who follows me will not walk in darkness”*, and how the sacrament of Confirmation will strengthen us to reflect the light of faith in our own lives, homes and communities.
