The Solemnity of Most Holy Trinity- Trinity Sunday The faith of all Is Not Christians rests on the Trinity – One God in three Divine Persons, "Christians Father are baptized in the *name* of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit: not in God their names, for there is only one God, the almighty Father, his only Son and the Holy Spirit: the MOST HOLY TRINITY." The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the "hierarchy of the truths of faith". The Trinity is a mystery of faith in the strict sense, one of the "mysteries that are hidden in God, which can never be known unless they are revealed by God". It is a mystery not in the sense of beyond understanding, but of something hidden and revealed by God to us. To be sure, God has left traces of his Trinitarian being in his work of creation and in his Revelation throughout the Old Testament. But his inmost Being as Holy Trinity is a mystery that is inaccessible to reason alone or even to Israel's faith before the Incarnation of God's Son and the sending of the Holy Spirit. "Glory be to the Father, and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen



The Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. June is dedicated to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus as a way of deepening our awareness of the Lord's love for us and furthering our devotion to His heart.
