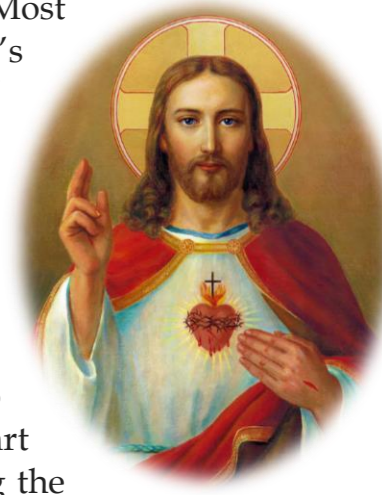

Hymn to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

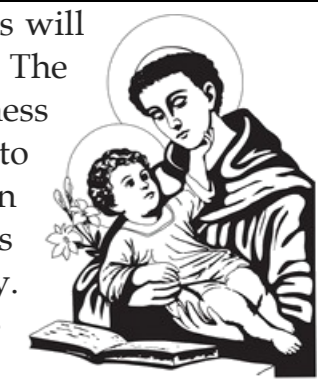

Saint Anthony's Day, Thursday, 13th June: The traditional blessing of Lillies will take place at the end of the 9:30am Mass in Curraha, in honour of St Anthony. The blessed lilies are given to the sick as a prayer for their recovery and the closeness of the Lord to them in their need. For centuries, pilgrims have brought lilies to the tomb of Saint Anthony in Padua, Italy. Pope Leo XIII granted permission to bless these flowers in honor of the saint. The tradition stems from various stories of miracles involving lilies and their connection to St. Anthony's purity. These blessed lilies remain sacramentals even after they fade or dry, much like blessed palms. Please bring lilies to be blessed.
