St. Mary's Church, Ardcath 11:30am 17th May 2025


St Andrew's Church, Curraha 11:30am 24th May 2025

All Souls Day is an invitation for the Faithful on earth (*the Church Militant*) to pray for the souls of the Faithful Departed in Purgatory (*the Church Suffering*) that they may attain to eternal life of heaven. The prayers offered to God to have mercy on the souls of the dead, to purify them by the fire of His charity, and to bring them into His Kingdom of life and light, find particular expression in the life of the Christian Faithful, filled as it with the hope of being reunited one day in heaven, and in charity in assisting our Beloved Deceased on their perfection by grace.

All Souls Mass: Saturday 10.00am Clonalvy

<u>Plenary Indulgences:</u> The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence, applicable only to the Holy Souls, on the usual conditions (**Confessions:** CLONALVY – Tuesday: after mass; CURRAHA – Thursday: after mass; ARDCATH – Friday: after mass), once per day from 1st to 8th November.
