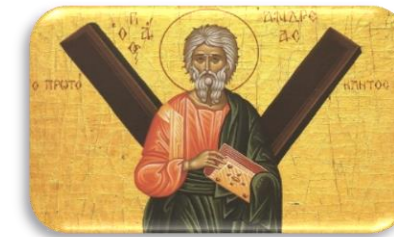

Feast of St Andrew – 30th Nov – Patron Saint of Curragha: Mass in honour of St Andrew – Saturday @ 11:00am. St Andrew is known as the 'First Called' as he was the first disciple chosen by Christ, who in turn called his brother Simon Peter to leave their fishing nets and follow the Lord. We ask his continued prayers as we recognise his patronage of our parish and as we honour him, we entrust the flourishing of our parish community into his powerful intercession. Parish Pastoral Assembly: Bishop Deenihan has called for the establishment of Parish Pastoral Assemblies (PPA) in every parish across the Diocese of Meath as a visible, practical and local sign of synodality. We are beginning the process of establishing a Parish Pastoral Assembly in our parish over the coming weeks and invite parishioners to reflect and pray about the role of an Assembly in our parish, how it can make a difference, and why you should consider becoming a member.

November List of the Dead: As the month of the Holy Souls has begun, parishioners are asked to prepare their family List of the Dead for prayers throughout November and the First Friday of the Month. The List of the Dead envelope can be found in the Parish Offertory Envelopes Box or in the church. Please drop them into the basket, the sacristy, or the Parish Office.



Altar Servers: We are welcoming children from 3rd class and upwards who would like to become altar servers. Application forms are available in the Sacristy and Parish Office. The ministry of altar server is an important one in the celebration of the liturgy, that also allows children to grow in the knowledge of the faith and its practice. Training dates will take place as soon as the applications forms have been submitted.
