

Feast of St Andrew - 30th Nov - Patron Saint of Curragha: Mass in honour of St Andrew - Saturday @ 11:00am. We ask his continued prayers as we recognise his patronage of our parish and as we honour him, we entrust the flourishing of our parish community into his powerful intercession.
