<u>Sunday of the Word of God:</u> Pope Francis asked that the 3rd Sunday of Ordinary Time be dedicated as Word of God Sunday to appreciate afresh the place of Sacred Scripture in our lives as Christians; whether reading the Bible privately, hearing it proclaimed at Mass or letting the Sacred Scriptures nurture our prayer life.

"The relationship between the Risen Lord, the community of believers and sacred Scripture is essential to our identity as Christians. Without the Lord who opens our minds to them, it is impossible to understand the Scriptures in depth. Yet the contrary is equally true: without the Scriptures, the events of the mission of Jesus and of his Church in this world would remain incomprehensible. Hence, Saint Jerome could rightly claim: "Ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance of Christ" (Pope Francis).

<u>#seek2025:</u> "What do you seek?" (John 1:38) SEEK is an invitation to explore life's bigger questions: who we are, where we're going and what we seek along the journey. As FOCUS' conference, SEEK encourages *everyone* to come explore what they truly seek: to learn about the faith, to share in friendship, to be encouraged in their unique vocation — and to experience the love, hope and very real presence of Jesus Christ through His Church.





<u>Bible in One Year</u>: Read the entire Bible in one year (365 days). Set aside a specific time each day, set a schedule, and then stick to it. Read the Bible to learn, not just to accomplish the next reading. Say a short prayer before you begin, asking the Holy Spirit to give you understanding and wisdom, and be refreshed by the word of God. (Google Play: Catholic Bible Offline Daily)

Christian Unity Week (18-25 January 2025): The theme this year is "Do you believe this?" reflecting the confession of Martha to Jesus in the Gospel of John, chapter 11. This year also marks the 1700th Anniversary of the Council of Nicaea in 325 which formulated the Nicene Creed we use to profess our faith each Sunday. Today, all Christians are called to renew our belief in God and to encounter God in Jesus, who is our hope, through the power and presence of the Holy Spirit.





<u>Catholic Schools Week 2025</u>: Sunday, 19 January, marks the beginning of Catholic Schools Week 2025. During this week we aim to celebrate the unique contribution that Catholic schools make to their communities. This year's theme is Catholic Schools: Alive in Christ. We pray for and support our local Catholic schools so that, together with us, the parish community, they will be alive with the joy and hope that is Christ.
